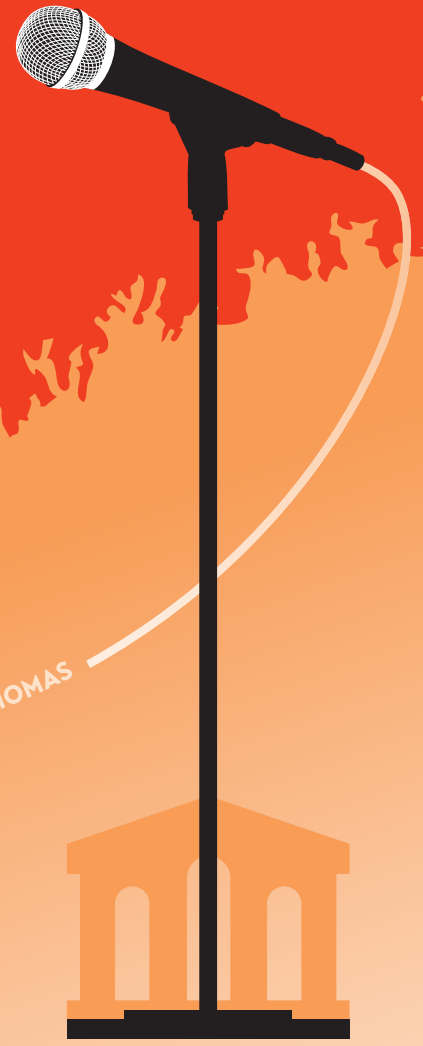


# MAINE POETRY EXPRESS
